The candidates, who had registered earlier after payment of online-counselling-cum-registration fee of Rs. 500/- through the payment gateway (<https://pmny.in/pleL8O99onDa>) are eligible to apply for the final round of Counselling-cum-Admission. The interested candidates are required to apply by “**Specifying the name of the Course (for which they have a valid CUCET Score)**” for admission in Khallikote University for the AY 2020-21 alongwith the following documents (scan copy) and soft copy of online fee payment receipt (**in favour of the Chairman, PG Council, Khallikote University**) as detailed below by email to ‘admission@khalikoteuniversity.ac.in’ on or before **28th November 2020** failing which your request for admission shall not be considered:

1. The ‘Admission form’ (should be downloaded from website, duly filled in and signed)
2. The ‘Undertaking form’ as the case deemed fit (should be downloaded from website and be duly filled in and signed)
3. Self-attested photocopy of Certificates and Mark sheets of all examinations from 10th (Secondary) class to Graduation (+3) and/or their equivalent.
4. Passport size photograph should be pasted in the admission form.
5. College leaving Certificate (CLC)
6. Conduct Certificate
7. Migration Certificate
8. Self attested photocopy of the certificates claiming reservation (SC/ST/PWD)
9. Receipt of fee payment made in favour of “**The Chairman, PG Council, Khallikote University, Berhampur (through online transfer to the Account no. 3695144745; Bank- Central Bank of India, Branch- Khallicote College Branch, Berhampur, Ganjam, Odisha; IFSC code. CBIN 0283241).**”

- Based on the email (alongwith copy of NEFT receipt, and scan copy of certificates and other documents) received within 28th November, 2020, the candidates will be provisionally admitted in order of merit against available vacancy under each category for each of the PG Courses.
- The provisionally admitted candidates will be intimated regarding their provisional admission and they will be required to send the documents as hard copy by speed post on or before 05th December, 2020. After receipt of the documents (hard copy) by their provisional admission will be completed.
- The fees of unsuccessful candidates will be returned after due process by 10th December, 2020.
- All the certificates and marksheets will be verified with original ones prior to the commencement of classes.
